

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Peach County School Nutrition will be participating in our third year of the USDA Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) through the National School Lunch Program. CEP permits eligible schools to provide meals to all students at no charge, regardless of economic status. CEP is available to all students enrolled in Peach County Schools.

What does this mean for you and your children?

All students are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch in school at no charge to your household each day of the **2018-2019** school year. No further action is required of you. Your children will be able to participate in this meal program without having to pay a fee or submit a Free and Reduced Meal Application.

Breakfast and lunch is provided at no cost to your children; however, supplemental sale items such as an extra entrée, ice cream, etc. will be available for purchase. These items can be purchased with cash or a check payable to PCSNP (Peach Co. School Nutrition Program). In order to prevent any charges to your child's account, he/she cannot not purchase supplemental sale items if they do not have cash or money in their meal account.

Finally, please encourage your children to maximize their eating experience by selecting all meal offerings. This will not only give them a more satisfying experience, but also provide them with the opportunity to eat more fruits and vegetables.
