One-Pager

A ONE-PAGER is a written and graphic interpretation of a reading presented on a SINGLE sheet of paper. It should demonstrate your thoughts and understanding of the information in color. NO part of the page should be left blank (if you want something to be white, you need to color it with white pencil or crayon). One entire side should be covered with information. Use the back of this paper to complete this assignment.

Instructions:

Choose a reading packet. The reading packets are class copies, so DO NOT write on them. Read the packet (notes are not required, but if you find that you want to take notes, make sure you do it on your own paper). If you would like your own copy of the reading, it will be available on my website. After reading the packet, make your one-pager.

Your ONE-PAGER needs to include:

- A title
- A **LARGE** diagram explaining the information. Multiple colors must be used to show concepts and key information.
- A **TEN WORD** (exactly) caption for the diagram, which is written under the diagram. This caption must summarize the ideas in your diagram.
- **TWO** additional pictures to illustrate your information. These can be small, but they also need to have multiple colors.
- A **QUOTE** from the reading. This quote must pertain to a concept or aspect of the topic and must emphasize a key point.
- At least **SIX** key pieces of information.
- At least **TWO** vocabulary words, highlighted and defined.
- A question box. Inside this question box, you must have **ONE** level 3 question **with an answer** explaining your concept.
