ASVAB Tidbits For Testing

To make your job easier in administering the ASVAB to your students, we are providing some tips for test promotion:

Tip #1: Please help your students to understand that the ASVAB is not just a test for students interested in the military! This is a great opportunity to link their achievement with their interest and to explore careers related to this information.

Tip #2: If students receive calls from military recruiting personnel and they are not interested then say so!

Tip #3: The school does have the option to omit student telephone numbers from the test scores. Notify the ASVAB office and request option #6 (404/469-3090 ext 261).

Tip #4: Counselors who perform classroom guidance prior to the ASVAB session have better participation. Myths are dispelled concerning the program.

Tip #5: Career Technology student participation is increasing. Make sure the CT department shares in the ASVAB promotional efforts.


Tip #6: Use the enclosed ASVAB registration form in classrooms. * Students may sign up when the PA announcement is read. *See ASVAB Postcard
