Parent's Right to Know

2016-2017

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires school districts that receive federal Title I funding to notify parents of their right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers and paraprofessionals who teach their child.

You have the right to request the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers and paraprofessionals:

- The professional qualifications of your child's teacher(s)
 - Whether the teacher met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject he/she is teaching
 - Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certification through which state qualifications were waived
 - What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration
 - If your child has been assigned, or has been taught for at least four consecutive weeks, by a teacher who does not meet the highly qualified definition
 - Whether paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications
 - Be involved in the planning and implementation of the parent involvement program in your child's school
- Contact the principal at your child's school for more information
