

## BYRON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

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Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires that parents or guardians who have children attending a Title I school be notified of how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or a career, as well as the school's designation status under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under the 2015 renewal of Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools continue to be designated as Reward, Priority, or Focus Schools. The Waiver allows the use of the College and Career Readiness Performance Index (CCRPI) as the comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, providing a score between 0-100 for each school – measuring how well the school is doing in preparing its students to be successful in college and/or a career.

Byron Elementary's most recent CCRPI score (2014) is 66.4. More information about the details of the score may be found on our school district website at [www.peachschools.org](http://www.peachschools.org). When new scores are received, they will be posted on our school website.

I am very proud to tell you that Byron Elementary has not been given a school designation this year, which means we are a Title I school that is continuing to provide a quality education to all of our students.
