DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS

1. Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right. Students will be expected to follow the guidelines outlined below to ensure continued parking and driving privileges. Tickets will be issued by the School Resource Officer for any parking and /or driving violations occurring on school property. Each ticket, except specifically marked warning tickets, will carry a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not greater than \$25.00. *Repeated violations and/or unpaid tickets* may result in the vehicle being towed and/or report cards and school records being held. **Tickets must be paid to the school bookkeeper within five (5) days of being issued.**
2. The school retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots. Student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has any reason to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.
3. All student vehicle operators must have a valid Georgia Operator's License. A motorcycle license is required for those who drive motorcycles onto campus.
4. In accordance with Georgia law, all vehicles must have a current license plate (decal) and minimal insurance to drive onto the school campus.
5. All vehicles, parked on campus, must display the current school year student parking permit. The cost to purchase parking permits is \$35.00 for the first one and \$5.00 for each additional permit. Permits must be placed on the inside front windshield, on the driver's side, in the lower left corner. Permits may not be transferred to any other vehicle. They are valid only for the vehicle that is registered with the school at the time the permit is issued. Any student violating this policy will have their parking privileges revoked immediately.
6. Failure to display a valid parking permit, driving a non-registered vehicle on campus or any other violations may result in the removal of the vehicle at the owner's expense.
7. Students may park only in the student parking lot in the proper manner. Students may not park in the faculty parking lot or along Bryant Drive and Campus Drive, and not in the circular drive in front of the school. Underclassmen are reminded that they are not permitted to park in the designated SENIOR parking spaces in the student parking lot.
8. Students must enter and leave the parking area only in the designated areas.
9. Speeding and/or reckless driving will not be tolerated on the school campus. All property of Peach County High School has a 15-mph posted speed limit. Parking privileges will be revoked for first (1st) time violators.
10. The local police and school officials have jurisdiction over the speed limits and other traffic violations on school property. Students receiving traffic citations on school property will be taken to city traffic court and a student behavioral report will be filed.
11. Students are required to exit their cars immediately upon arrival on the school grounds. Loitering in cars is forbidden. At the end of the school day, all student vehicles must be removed from the student parking lot.
12. Students may not return to their vehicles at any time unless they have prior written approval from a school administrator.
13. Students are forbidden to have any weapons in their vehicles, including in any gun rack within their vehicle, concealed under seats or in any other place within or on their vehicle. Under Georgia Law Code 16-11-127.1, carrying weapons within school safety zones is a serious felony crime. All violators will be prosecuted.
14. Peach County High School will not be responsible for any damage or theft to vehicles or their contents which may occur while parked on campus. This includes, but is not limited to, negligence, vandalism, fire, or destructive acts of nature.
15. The use of trained drug sniffing dogs will be brought on campus to the student parking lot on random and unannounced occasions by law-enforcement officers. Any controlled substances found inside any vehicle will be turned over to the proper legal authorities for ultimate disposition. Students are reminded, under Georgia Criminal Laws, possession of a controlled substance is a very serious felony crime. All violators will be prosecuted.
