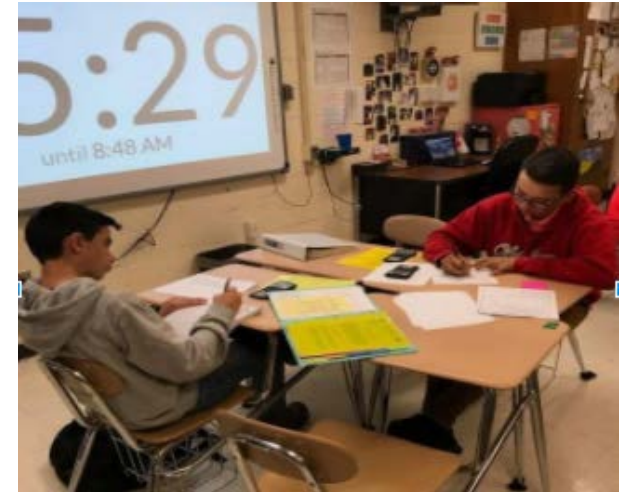
Peach County High School has earned a consistent climate rating of 3 out of 5 stars for the past 4 years.

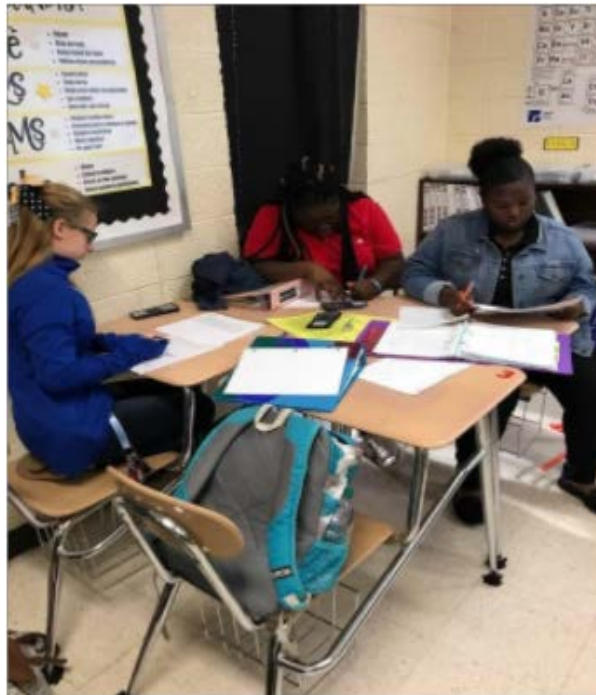
Notable Achievements
